

Dear Parent

CBSE has introduced the following changes for the present Class IX students, and these will continue to be applicable when they move to Class X.

● Assessment Structure for Classes IX and X

The assessment structure for Classes IX and X comprises two mandatory components:

- Annual Examination
- Internal Assessment**

The final result of the student will be determined by combining the performance in both the Annual Examination and the Internal Assessment. Students are required to appear in and complete both components of assessment.

To be declared successful in a subject, a student must secure a **minimum of 33% marks separately in Annual Examination and Internal Assessment.**

● Languages

As per CBSE Circular CBSE/Acad/SoS/2026 dated 15 May 2026,

Excerpt from the Circular

With effect from 1st July 2026, the Three-Language Formula shall be implemented for Class IX.

Study of three languages (R1, R2, R3) shall be compulsory for all students.

Languages offered are:

R1 – English

R2 – Hindi

R3 – Sanskrit

At least two of the three languages shall be native Indian languages as per the prescribed guidelines

For Class IX, two native Indian languages will be Hindi and Sanskrit. The non-native Indian language will be English. **This will be put in effect from 01 July 2026 if no further changes are received from CBSE.**

● Vocational Education

Kaushal Vikas will be taken up as part of the **Work Experience classes**. The students will be assessed throughout the year through continuous and regular activities. In addition to the year-round assessment, there will be an **annual pen-and-paper assessment of 25 marks.**

This will help students develop practical skills, responsibility, and a better understanding of work-based learning. It may also be noted that **Board assessment for this subject is expected from the next academic session**, and therefore regular participation and assessment will be important.

• School-Based Internal Assessment Subjects

The following subjects will be taken up using the study material provided by CBSE and will include **School-Based Internal Assessment**:

- Interdisciplinary Subject – Individuals in Society
(Module-based, content is awaited from CBSE.)
- Computational Thinking and AI
(Module-based content is awaited from CBSE.)

• Optional Advanced Level Papers

Students may opt for **Mathematics Advanced** and/or **Science Advanced**. These papers will be based on **Additional Content** and will consist of **higher level competency based questions**.

➤ Reflection in Marksheet

A student securing **50% and above** in the optional Advanced Examination will have the following reflected in the marksheet:

“The Advanced Level has been successfully cleared.”

The above text is tentative and may vary as per CBSE directions.


- The marks obtained in the Advanced Examination will **not be added to the overall aggregate or total score**.
- In case a student secures less than the prescribed criteria, **no reference to the Advanced Level will be reflected in the marksheet**.
- **IMPORTANT NOTE**
 - As of now, classes for **Advanced Mathematics** and **Advanced Science** are being conducted for all students. An assessment based on the content covered will be held during the **first two weeks of July**.
 - The choice forms for opting for **Advanced Mathematics** and/or **Advanced Science** will be made available after this assessment. This assessment in July will help students and parents make a more informed choice.

• Optional Subject (Skill Subject)

All students are going to be taught the subject **Artificial Intelligence** (Subject Code: 417).
